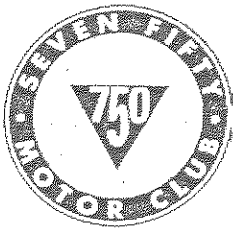

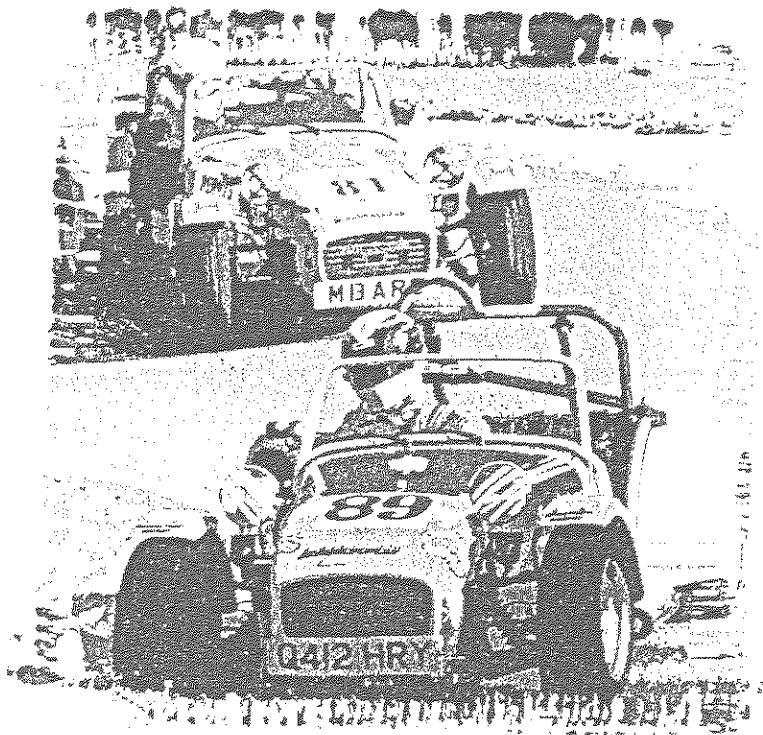

First introduced in 2001, the 750 Motor Club's RGB Championship is for two-seater cars which must be road legal and capable of passing an MOT. Cars may be constructed specifically for the series or may be one of the many motorcycle engine cars currently available from a wide range of kit car manufacturers. The engines must be series-production four-stroke units and may not be modified from standard; they run in four classes; standard Fireblade engine kit cars (class C), up to 135 bhp (class B), 136 to 180 bhp (class A) and rear-engined cars (class D). The 750 Motor Club Formula Vee championship is ideal for beginner and 'expert' alike, looking for competitive single seater racing on a low budget. It has been run by the 750 Motor Club since 1980 and is probably the cheapest way to go single seater racing in the UK. Engine, gearbox and much of the suspension and braking system is from the VW 1300 Beetle and this, along with a Dunlop 'control' tyre puts the emphasis on driver ability to win races.

# Marshalling

As an active alternative to competing, you could become one of the hundreds of hardy souls who clad themselves in orange overalls each weekend, to carry out the variety of jobs essential to the safe running of an event. It's a serious undertaking and can get you very close to the action at times.

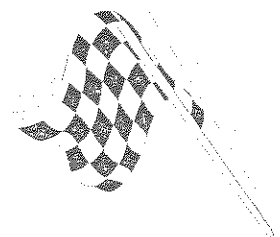
Course, Incident, Flag, Observer, Pits, Paddock, Assembly, Race Rescue Unit - all these basically come under the umbrella of marshalling. However, you don't just come along and do whatever job you fancy on the day; there is a lot more to it than that. Those with no experience start as Trainees and will be placed with experienced marshals at whatever position they are allocated. Training days are available, ranging from fire-fighting, incident handling, use and knowledge of the many flags through to, after years of experience, becoming Examining Observer or Specialist.

The 750 Motor Club looks after its Marshals, realising only too well that they are all volunteers and it has a Sponsorship Scheme to assist new marshals to buy the necessary kit (overalls, wet weather gear etc) or to help with their replacement; this funding uniquely comes directly from the 750 Motor Club competitors by way of donations to our Marshals Fund.

With its 28 race days, plus Sprints, Trials, the Formula Student event, the Shell Eco-Marathon and the London-to-Brighton run, the 750 Motor Club has lots to offer to both new or experienced Marshals.
