Caterham 7 or Lotus 7, in four classes determined by which engine is fitted, as is the car's minimum weight, in order to equalise performance as much as possible within each class.

Engine options include Ford 1700 Xflow, Lotus 1600 Twincam, Vauxhall 2-litre, Rover 1400K & 1600K, Superlight-R, Roadsports 1600K, Academy, Graduate and Super Graduate.

Some are not permitted any modifications, others are 'full-house'.

Class A permits freedom of braking system (excluding ABS). Classes B, C & D only permit freedom of friction material.

Close ratio gears and limited slip differentials are permitted as per the regulations.

Control tyre is the Yokohama A032R on a rim width of 6" maximum.

Cars may be constructed specifically for the series or may be one of the many motorcycle engined cars currently available from a wide range of kit car manufacturers. The engines must be series-production four-stroke units and may not be modified from standard; they run in three classes; standard Fireblade engined kit cars (class C), up to 135 bhp (class B), 136 to 180 bhp and rear-engined cars (class A).

New for 2004 is a Yokohama control tyre, the A048R.


'Trump Card' 750 Formula Championship

750 Formula is for lightweight two-seater sports racing cars, originally introduced by the 750 MC in 1949, as its first racing formula. The regulations provide ample scope for the budding amateur to design and build his own car, and to develop his skills in chassis / suspension design and engine tuning within carefully controlled limits; alternatively there are often suitable cars available for sale from within the formula. There are two engine options, either the highly tuned Reliant 850cc or the unmodified Fiat 'FIRE' 1108cc, the latter introduced in 2003 due to the diminishing supply of spares for the Reliant engine. All cars run on a control Yokohama slick tyre.

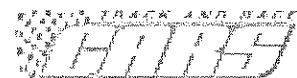
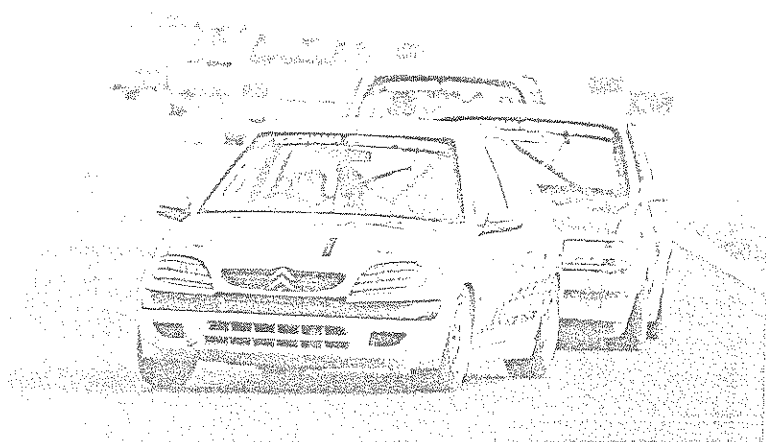

Demon Tweeks/Yokohama Hot Hatch Championship

'Hatchbacks', available for sale in the UK (class A cars for at least three years prior to the current season). 'Homologation Specials' are not permitted. There are three classes which include:- up to 1400cc multi-valve, up to 1600cc two valve and 1601 – 2000cc. Equality of performance is maintained by the amount of engine tuning permitted and by the ballasting of winning cars. Engines must be the original (type) fitted to the car; varies from simple 'blueprinting', to changing pistons, valves, carbs & exhaust, dependant upon class. Springs and dampers are free, including coil-overs, provided they utilise the original pick-up points. The original gearbox must be used; close-ratio gears are OK in class A. Final drive ratio is free. LSD or similar is not permitted. All cars run on the Yokohama A032R or 510; rim width is free provided they fit within the standard bodywork.

WILLOW KINGS Kit Car Championship

The 750 Motor Club Kit Car Championship is for Genuine 'production' kit cars, front or rear engined, specifically excluding 'one-off' specials. Chassis and bodywork materials and the design concept may not be changed. Cars must be capable of passing an MoT test. Engines must be production-car based, with a maximum of 3500cc and a separate class (B) for 1800cc Ford Zetec engines. Multi-valve engines are included within limits; engine tuning is restricted and turbos/superchargers are not permitted. Apart from the prohibition of calipers other than cast iron, braking systems are free, but no ABS. Gearbox and diff must be from a production car. Close ratio gears are permitted, maximum 5-speed plus reverse. No limited slip diff or similar. The control tyre is the Yokohama A032R. Rim width is 6" or 7" depending upon class.

If it's a sportscar produced in a reasonable volume, it's probably eligible.

Current makes/marques include Aston Martin, Clan, Ferrari, Ginetta, Jensen Healey, Lotus, Marcos, MG, Morgan, Porsche, Renault, TVR, Triumph and Turner.

There is no more varied a Championship for sportscars in the UK and its split into separate classes based generally on engine capacity/car type.

Engine must be original fitment, but crank, rods, pistons, camshaft, induction and exhaust are free; head mods are permitted; add-on turbos/superchargers are not permitted.

Power outputs will vary between 100bhp in the small class, to getting on for 350+ bhp in the big V8s. Transmission must be a production-car gearbox. Close-ratio gears and LSD are permitted, traction control is not.
