Welcome to the 750 Motor Club's first race meeting of 2005 at Brands Hatch, where nearly 450 entries of 750 Motor Club classes along with three of the MG Car Club's championships, underlines the popularity of top-value grass roots racing.

Sunday's Stock Hatch round has attracted a staggering 92 entries, which justifies no fewer than two heats and a final; normally the quickest cars from the heats go into the final but, unless any drivers fail to qualify in practice, there are still two reserves! Seasoned competitor Darren Blumson leads the points table from the less experienced Maurice Hayden, but there will be thrills aplenty before the weekend's winners climb the steps to the podium.

A similarly tough battle awaits the Formula Vee combatants on Saturday, as proof once again that the buzzing VW Beetle engined single-seater class – which pre-dated the arrival of Formula Ford in the UK by three weeks in 1967 – is more than a load of hot air.

Martyn Donn heads the points in his late-model Scarab, but watch for defending champion Mike Jenvey and returnée Patrick Sherrington up at the sharp end of the final grid.

More frenetically close racing is guaranteed in the Locost championship round, where past master Brian Mitcham came under fire from Mini graduate Declan McDonnell at Mallory Park's opener for the 1300cc Ford-powered cars.

Whether saloons, sportcars or single-seaters are your favourites, the hallowed Indy circuit will test their drivers to the limit. And the amphitheatre setting means that wherever you choose to watch, wheel-to-wheel drama will be close at hand.

Gearbox and diff must be from a production car. The control tyre is the Yokohama AO32R/AO48R. Rim width is 6" or 7" depending upon class.

If it's a sportscar produced in a reasonable volume, it's probably eligible - there is no more varied a Championship for sportscars in the UK and its split into separate classes based generally on engine capacity/car type. Engine must be original fitment, but crank, rods, pistons, camshaft, induction and exhaust are free; head mods are permitted; add-on forced induction is not permitted. Power outputs will vary between 100bhp in the small class, to getting on for 350+bhp in the big V8s. Transmission must be a production-car gearbox. Close-ratio gears and LSD are permitted, traction control is not.

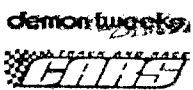

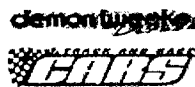
