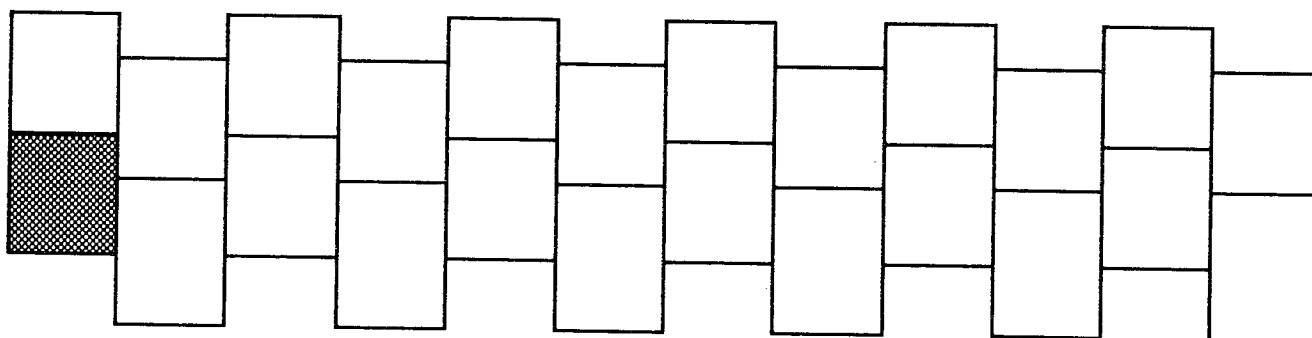

Class B is for cars running to Sports 2000 regulations and Class C is for former Multisports cars. 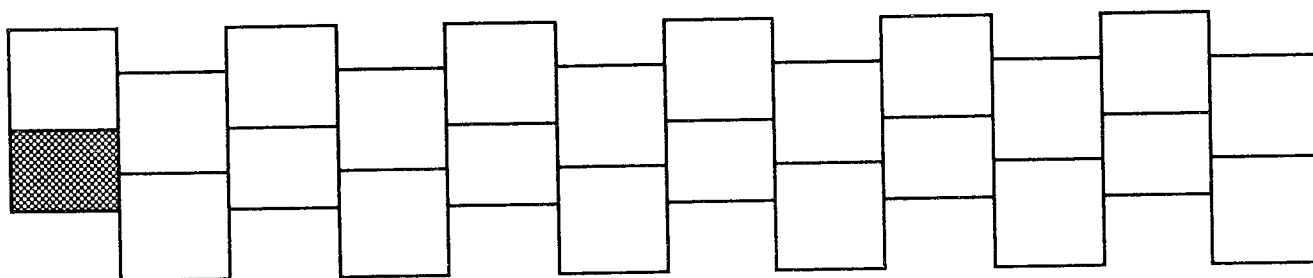
The ACS LIMITED Kit Car Championship is ideal for the driver who wants to construct his own vehicle from a proven design. The front-engined roadgoing Kit Cars must be fully road legal with current MoT Certificates and run on road tyres. The engine regulations allow considerable freedom, but the standard carburation and inlet manifold from the donor car must be retained. To control costs there are limitations on the design of the rear suspension, the transmission and on the use of spherical bearings. There are two classes, up to 1660 cc and 1661 - 3500 cc. Engines up to 1700 cc can run twin side draft carburettors and run in the bigger class. Formula Vee is the ideal championship for beginner and 'expert' alike, looking for competitive single seater racing on a low budget. It has been run by the 750 Motor Club since 1980 and is probably the cheapest way to go single seater racing in the UK. Cars can be bought fully constructed, in 'kit' form, designed and built by the driver or hired ready to go. Engine, gearbox and much of the suspension and braking system is from the VW 1300 Beetle and this, along with a Dunlop 'control' tyre puts the emphasis on driver ability to win races.

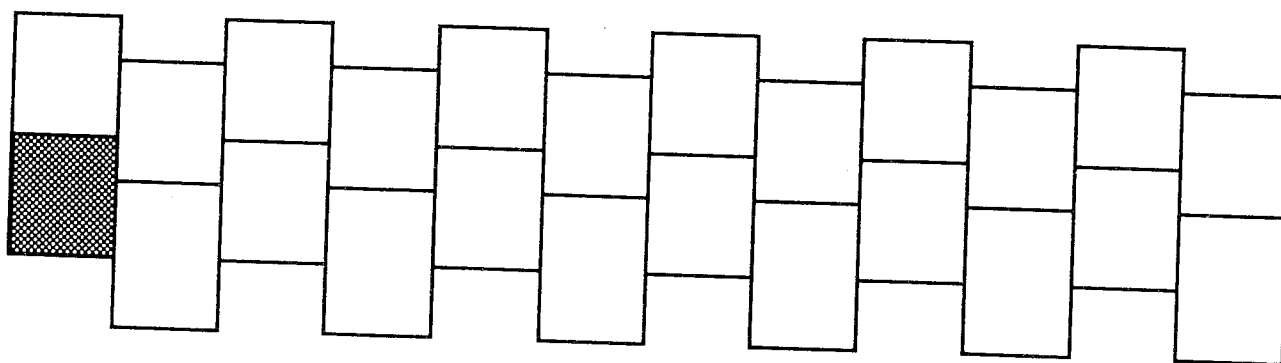
The 1996 Advent Multimedia Seven Challenge is for the two Caterham / Lotus 7 classes from the successful Roadsports championship run for many years by the 750 MC. Class E is for 1600cc Xflow engined cars from the Caterham Classic Scholarship series and cars from the Caterham K Series. Class F is for the more modified 1700 cc Xflow, Lotus twincam and Vauxhall 2 litre cars, with specified engine modifications to give equivalent power outputs. Clean, close and competitive racing is assured from these road legal versions of "Colin Chapman's four wheel motorbike".

The 1996 Yokohama Formula 4 Championship provides the technical sophistication of slicks and wings in an affordable single seater championship. Class A allows any design of chassis and caters for the designer/constructor as well as for cars converted from F3, FFord, FF2000 and Formula Renault; all must use either 1300 Xflow or 1600 CVH Ford engines. Class B is for FF2000 cars built prior to October 1983, running to the former FF2000 regulations.

The NEWEYS SUPERSPORTS championship has been expanded for 1996 and the range of vehicles eligible now includes two seater sports-racing cars and cars based on two seater Kit cars and Sportscars. One-off designs are permitted, but the use of single seater chassis is not allowed. The range of tuning is virtually unlimited except that forced induction is not permitted. Cars run in three classes:- up to 2400 cc multivalve; up to 2100 cc two valve per cylinder; over 2100 cc two valve per cylinder. The championship again receives support from NEWEYS JEWELLERY CENTRE in Birmingham.

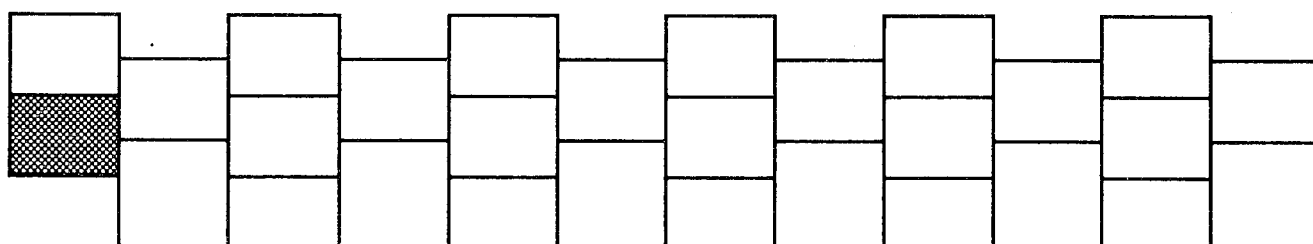

750 Formula is for lightweight two-seater sports racing cars and was originally introduced by the 750 MC in 1949, as its first racing formula. The regulations provide ample scope for the budding amateur to design and build his own car, and to develop his skills in chassis / suspension design and engine tuning within carefully controlled limits; alternatively there are often suitable cars available for sale from within the formula. The championship is supported by WESPNEY CASTINGS of Willenhall, whose foundry produces a wide range of aluminium castings for both general and automotive use, including 'one-off' productions.

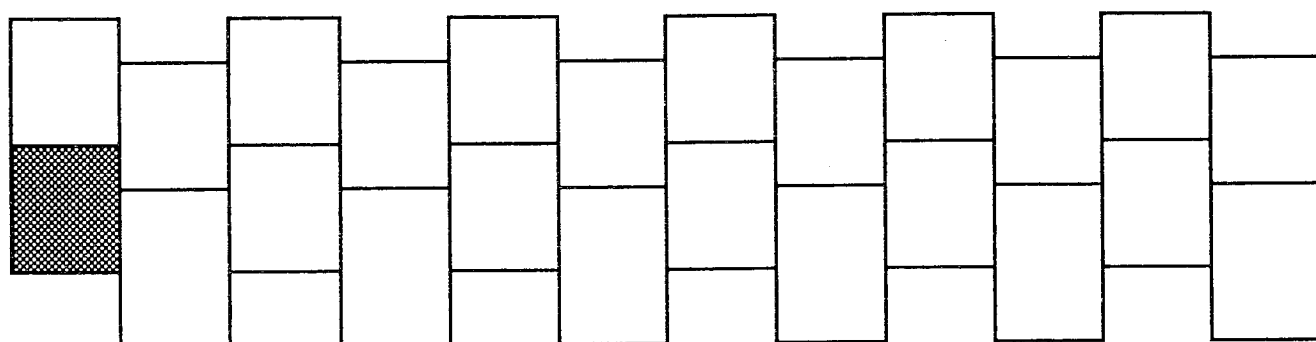

The 750 Trophy Series was started in 1994 as a number of one-off non-championship races and sprints for Austin Seven based cars, supported by other cars of historic interest and similar performance. As in the former pre-war Austin 7 Championship, Austin Sevens will compete in three classes:- Austin Seven sports and racing cars, post-war specials and early 750 Formula cars with Austin Seven engines/gearboxes. To provide support, cars will be invited from the old 1172 Formula along with vintage, PVT and historic cars such as 500cc Formula 3, MGs, Rileys, HRG, Jowetts and other similar vehicles.
