750 Formula is for lightweight two-seater sports racing cars and was originally introduced by the 750 MC in 1949, as its first racing formula. The regulations provide ample scope for the budding amateur to design and build his own car, and to develop his skills in chassis / suspension design and engine tuning within carefully controlled limits; alternatively there are often suitable cars available for sale from within the formula. The championship is supported by WESPREY CASTINGS of Willenhall, whose foundry produces a wide range of aluminium castings for both general and automotive use, including 'one-off' productions.

The ACS LIMITED Kit Car Championship is ideal for the driver who wants to construct his own vehicle from a proven design. The front-engined roadgoing Kit Cars must be fully road legal with current MoT Certificates and run on road tyres. The engine regulations allow considerable freedom, but the standard carburation and inlet manifold from the donor car must be retained. To control costs there are limitations on the design of the rear suspension, the transmission and on the use of spherical bearings. There are two classes, up to 1660 cc and 1661 - 3500 cc. Engines up to 1700 cc can run twin side draft carburettors and run in the bigger class. Formula Vee is the ideal championship for beginner and 'expert' alike, looking for competitive single seater racing on a low budget. It has been run by the 750 Motor Club since 1980 and is probably the cheapest way to go single seater racing in the UK. Cars can be bought fully constructed, in 'kit' form, designed and built by the driver or hired ready to go. Engine, gearbox and much of the suspension and braking system is from the VW 1300 Beetle and this, along with a Dunlop 'control' tyre puts the emphasis on driver ability to win races.


