Cars are allowed no modifications to engine or gearbox, limited suspension modifications, standard pattern brakes and all must use the Yokohama A510 'control' tyre. This together with a weight penalty for leading cars ensures close and competitive racing within very reasonable budgets.

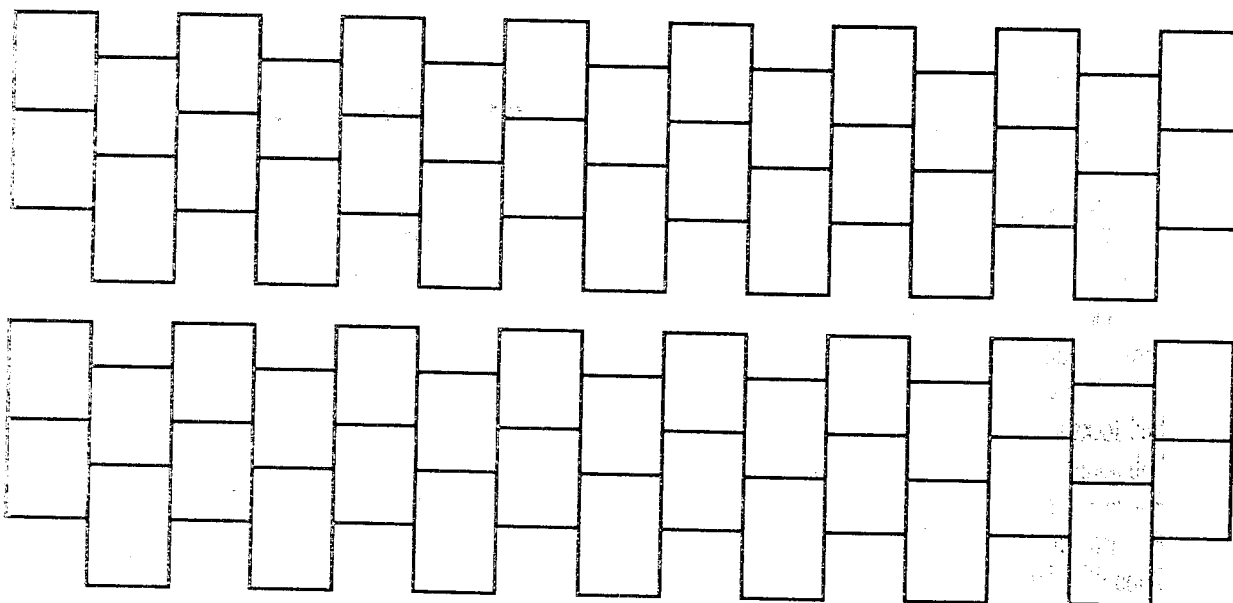

The HELLA Formula Vee championship is ideal for beginner and 'expert' alike, looking for competitive single seater racing on a low budget. It has been run by the 750 Motor Club since 1980 and is probably the cheapest way to go single seater racing in the UK. Cars can be bought fully constructed, in 'kit' form, designed and built by the driver or hired ready to go. Engine, gearbox and much of the suspension and braking system is from the VW 1300 Beetle and this, along with a Dunlop 'control' tyre puts the emphasis on driver ability to win races. For 1997, the championship has support from HELLA.
