Today's race for the 1997 HELLA Formula Vee championship will be made up of the fastest 28 (the maximum number permitted to race) from the two 'qualifying' practice sessions in the morning.

The HELLA Formula Vee championship is ideal for beginner and 'expert' alike, looking for competitive single seater racing on a low budget. It has been run by the 750 Motor Club since 1980 and is probably the cheapest way to go single seater racing in the UK. Cars can be bought fully constructed, in 'kit' form, designed and built by the driver or hired ready to go. Engine, gearbox and much of the suspension and braking system is from the VW 1300 Beetle and this, along with a Dunlop 'control' tyre puts the emphasis on driver ability to win races. For 1997, the championship has support from HELLA.

The 750 Motor Club is delighted to be returning to Mallory Park circuit for another full programme of action-packed races on Sunday 1st June - be sure to come and watch the Best of Club Motor Racing.

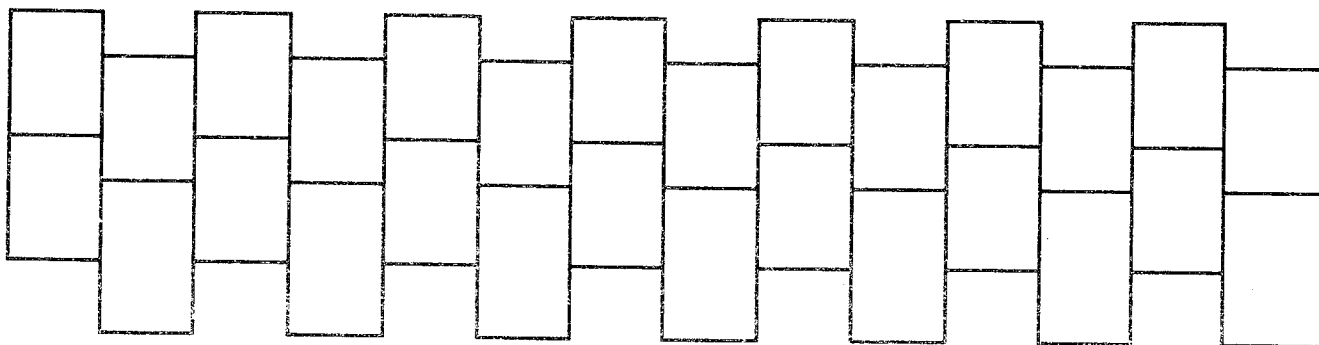




