Cars can be bought fully constructed, in 'kit' form, designed and built by the driver or hired ready to go. Engine, gearbox and much of the suspension and braking system is from the VW 1300 Beetle and this, along with a Dunlop 'control' tyre puts the emphasis on driver ability to win races. For 1997, the championship has support from HELLA.
