Demon Tweaks, Yokohama tyres and Cars & Car Conversions Magazine are the main sponsors for this year's Hot Hatch Championship which attracts a wide range of popular hatchback cars of up to 1600cc (or 1400 multi-valve). Cars are allowed relatively limited engine and suspension modifications, standard pattern brakes and all must use the Yokohama A510 'control' tyre. This together with a weight penalty for leading cars ensures close racing without excessive budgets.
