Class R is for the Radical Clubsports 1100, running with a Kawasaki 100cc engine & gearbox.

Cars are allowed relatively limited engine and suspension modifications, standard pattern brakes and all must use the Yokohama A510 'control' tyre. This together with a weight penalty for leading cars ensures close racing without excessive budgets.
