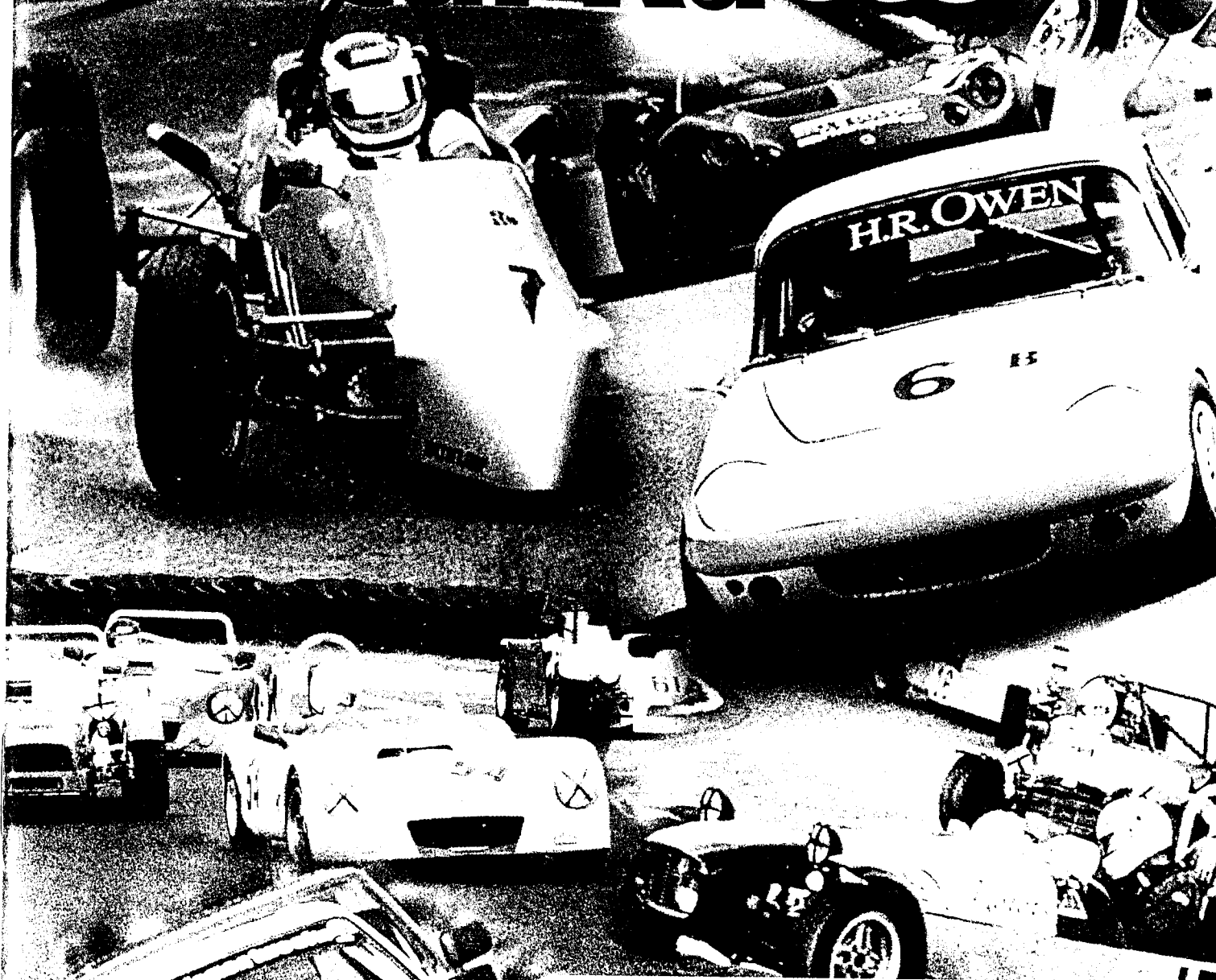

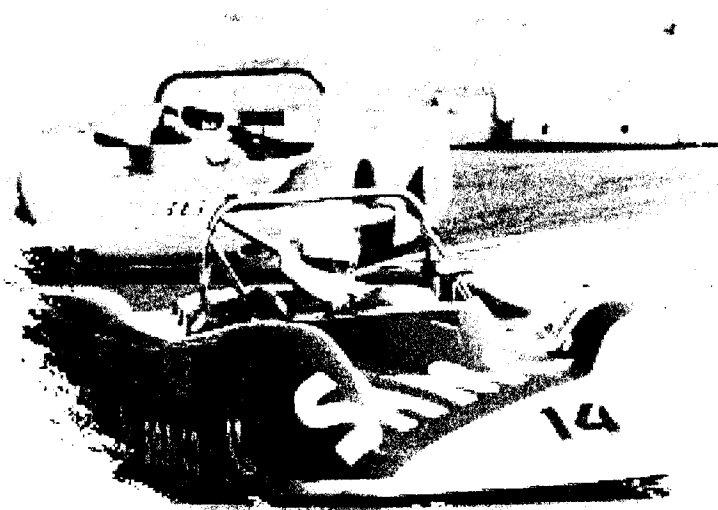

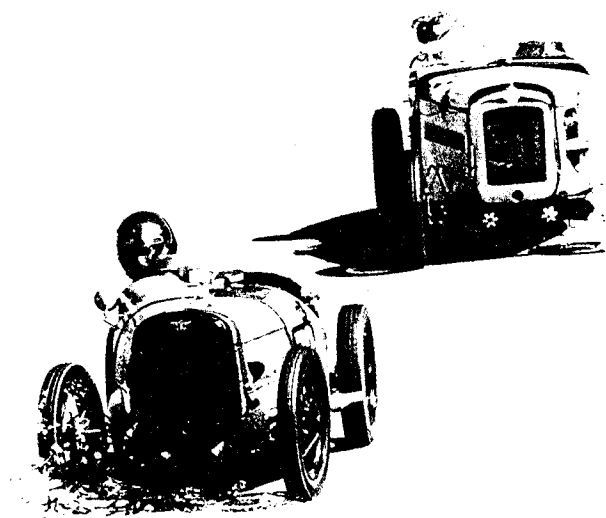
The 750 Motor Club Sports 2000 Championship is for front or rear engine two seater sports racing cars using a wide variety of engines (Ford Zetec, 1700cc Ford Xflow, Ford YAC, Ford 'Pinto', Vauxhall 1.6v 2 litre, Rover 1600 'K' series and production motorcycle engines of up to 146 bhp). Cars may be converted Sports 200, Clubmans, Vauxhall Supersports or other proprietary makes, plus purpose-built specials such as the WEV. To help even-out performance differences there are minimum weights for each category and the top three in each race will be awarded ballast for future races.

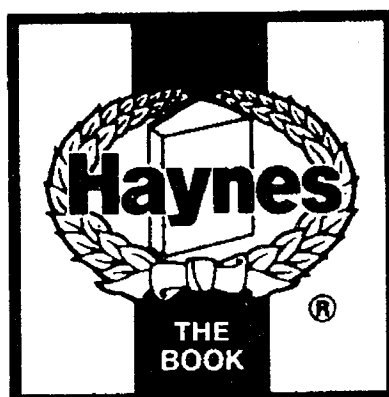

The 750 Motor Club Locost Series was started in 1999 and is being promoted by the 750 Motor Club, with sponsorship from Haynes Publishing, to encourage newcomers to construct and race a car built to a standard specification, very much in line with the 'ethos' of the Club. The 'Locost' was originally designed by Ron Champion, a teacher at Oundle School in Peterborough, as a project for his technology pupils. Such was the success that over 50 have been constructed within the school, a very popular book has been published and it is intended that this should be yet another of the 750 Motor Club's formulae aimed squarely at getting people involved in Motorsport.

The above will take part in the 1st Vee practice session. From the combined practice times, the slowest 30 will go into Race 10, the remainder into Race 13. Any spaces left on the back of that grid will be filled by the top finishers in Race 10.

The REMARC Formula Vee championship is ideal for beginner and 'expert' alike, looking for competitive single seater racing on a low budget. It has been run by the 750 Motor Club since 1980 and is probably the cheapest way to go single seater racing in the UK. Engine, gearbox and much of the suspension and braking system is from the VW 1300 Beetle and this, along with a Dunlop 'control' tyre puts the emphasis on driver ability to win races. For 2000, the championship has support from REMARC TECHNOLOGIES who specialise in computer software training courses.

750 Formula is for lightweight two-seater sports racing cars and was originally introduced by the 750 MC in 1949, as its first racing formula. The regulations provide ample scope for the budding amateur to design and build his own car, and to develop his skills in chassis / suspension design and engine tuning within carefully controlled limits; alternatively there are often suitable cars available for sale from within the formula.

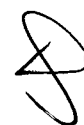
