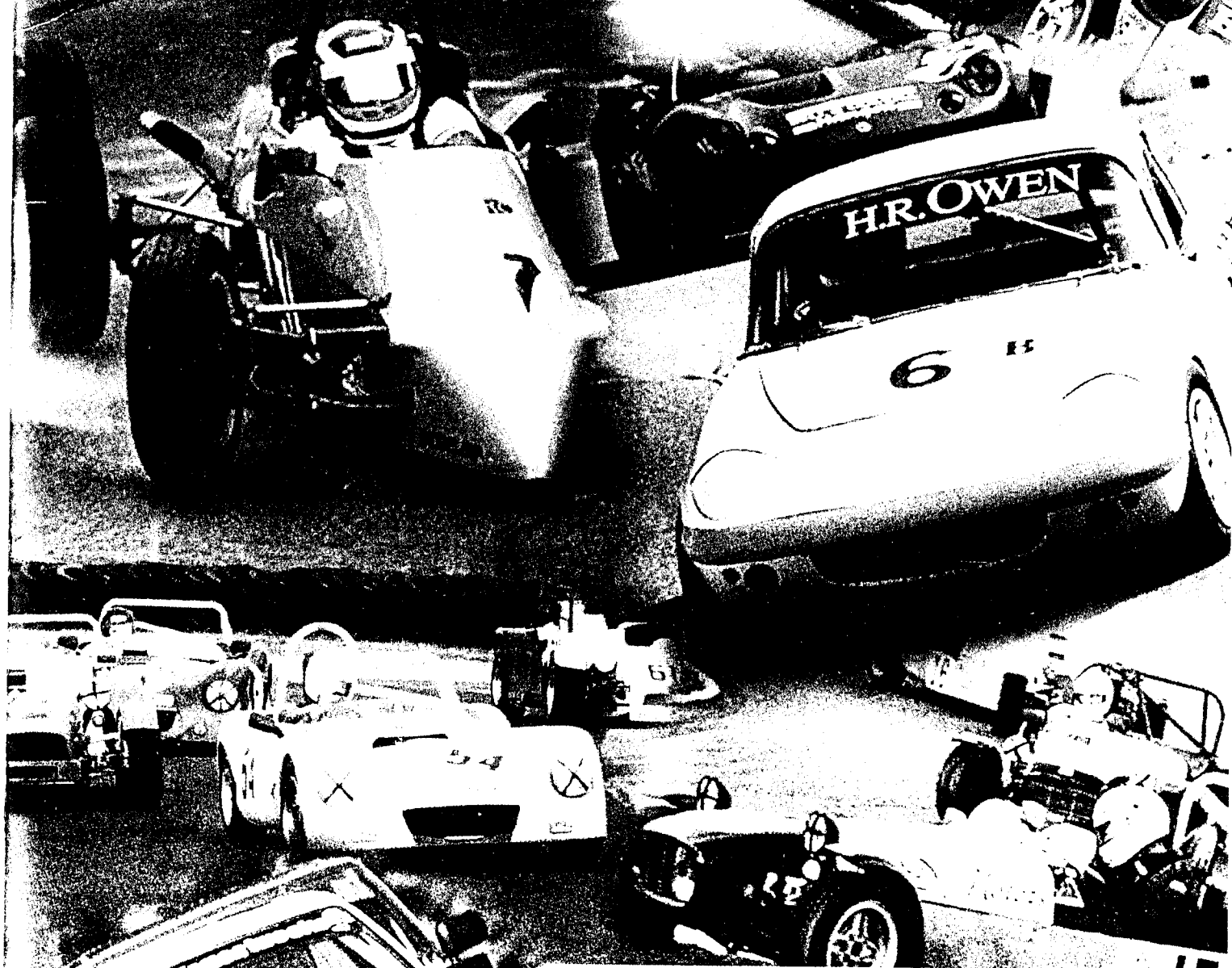

**The above drivers will take part in the 1<sup>st</sup> Formula Vee practice session; those listed as Race 10 will be in the 2<sup>nd</sup> practice session. From the combined practice times, the slowest 32 will go into Race 6, the remainder going through to Race 10. Any spaces left on the back of that grid will be filled by the top finishers in Race 6.**

The REMARC Formula Vee championship is ideal for beginner and 'expert' alike, looking for competitive single seater racing on a low budget. It has been run by the 750 Motor Club since 1980 and is probably the cheapest way to go single seater racing in the UK. Engine, gearbox and much of the suspension and braking system is from the VW 1300 Beetle and this, along with a Dunlop 'control' tyre puts the emphasis on driver ability to win races. For 2000, the championship has support from REMARC TECHNOLOGIES who specialise in computer software training courses.

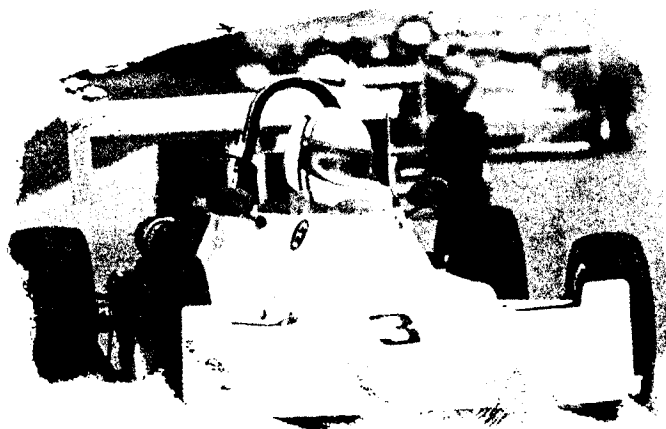
750 Formula is for lightweight two-seater sports racing cars and was originally introduced by the 750 MC in 1949, as its first racing formula. The regulations provide ample scope for the budding amateur to design and build his own car, and to develop his skills in chassis / suspension design and engine tuning within carefully controlled limits; alternatively there are often suitable cars available for sale from within the formula.

The 750 Motor Club Formula 4 Championship provides the technical sophistication of slicks and wings in an affordable single seater championship. Class A allows any design of chassis and caters for the designer/constructor as well as for cars converted from F3, FFord, FF2000 and Formula Renault; all must use either 1300 Xflow or 1600 CVH Ford engines. Class B is for FF2000 cars built prior to October 1983, class C for pre Dec '80, running to the former FF2000 regulations.


